This is the last Will and Testament of me
Manus Gallagher of Patutahi in the Provincial
District of Auckland and Colony of New Zealand
settler at present in the Hospital at Gisborne in
the Provincial District of Auckland aforesaid made this
Third day of December One thousand Eight hundred
and Eighty six. I do hereby revoke all former
Wills and Testamentary dispositions made by me and
declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
I appoint John Jorntley of Gisborne aforesaid
Cabinetmaker Executor of this my will. I do hereby
direct my said Executor to pay all my just debts and
Testamentary expenses. I give and bequeath unto
Annie Hills wife of Joseph Edward Hills of Patutahi
aforesaid Settler and Bridget Rogers wife of
Patrick Rogers of Patutahi aforesaid the sum of One
hundred Pounds each such sums to be paid by my
brother Owen Gallagher within five years from the date
of my death and in the meantime such sums with
interest at the rate of Seven pounds ten shillings per
Centum per annum to be a charge on my half share
and interest in the freehold section number one
hundred and twenty eight Patutahi with the Hotel
erected thereon. And I direct that the payment of the said
sums shall as soon after my death as practical be secured
by separate mortgages to each of them the said Annie
Hills and Bridget Rogers over my said half share
and interest. And I further direct that my said brother
shall pay to each of them the said Annie Hills and
Bridget Rogers interest at the rate aforesaid to
be computed from the day of my death on the said
sums annually. I give devise and bequeath
all the Residue of my real and personal Estate whatso
ever and whosoever. Subject to the Charges before mentioned
unto my said brother Owen Gallagher absolutely. I
direct and request that the sum of Seventy pounds
shall be expended in the erection of a suitable Tomb
Stone over my grave. Such sum of Seventy pounds
to be paid out of the Cash in my possession and
to my credit in Bank at the time of my death

And out of the debt due to me at the time of my death. Provided that if there shall not be sufficient Cash and debts as aforesaid to pay my said debts and the said sum of Seventy pounds my brother Owen Gallagher shall contribute one half and the said Annie Hills and Bridget Rogers one fourth Each of any deficiency.
